



How it all started


> Directive 89/391/EEC - OSH "Framework Directive"

- > 1994 implementation in Dutch Working Conditions Act
 - Communication
 - Support





How it all started





Development national policy

- RI&E mandatory for business owners with any staff
 - reviewed by a certified occupational health and safety service/specialist
- Since 2011
 - exemption of the review for businesses with max. 25 employees
 - Make use of recognized branch RI&E






Strategic objectives

Involvement social partners




- Branch organisation has to update the tool after 3 years
