EQUIPMENT MANAGEMENT

Organisational part of the Agency entrusted with the processing of personal data

Head of CPU (information(at)osha.europa.eu)

Purpose

Cleaning of any personal data contained on ICT equipment.

Legal basis

- Regulation (EU) 2019/126 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 January 2019 establishing the European Agency for Safety and Health at Work (EU-OSHA).
- Commission Decision No 46/2017 of 10 January 2017 concerning the security of communication and information systems in the EU.

Type of data processed

Any personal data that could have been stored in the ICT equipment.

Lawfulness of processing

The processing is based on Article 5.1 (a) of <u>Regulation (EU) 2018/1725</u> of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 October 2018 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter the Regulation).

Data recipients

ICT administrators

The data subject's rights

Data subjects have the right to request from the controller access to and rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing concerning the data subject or, where applicable, the right to object to processing or the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal (Articles 17, 18, 19, 20, 22, 23 and 24 of the Regulation).

Any requests to exercise one of those rights should be directed per email to information(at)osha.europa.eu, mentioning the organisational part of the Agency entrusted with the processing operation as indicated in this privacy statement





and the name of the processing operation, including in the subject the words "data protection".

Data subjects' rights can be restricted only in the cases foreseen in Art 25 of the Regulation.

Information on the conservation period of data

ICT equipment is wiped after a maximum of 30 days after the end user has stopped making use of the device.

Security measures

ICT devices are completely wiped when internally reused and securely wiped when taken out of service. Hard drives from servers are sent for physical destruction.

Request for information

Recourse to the EDPS

Data subjects are entitled to make recourse to the European Data Protection Supervisor: http://www.edps.europa.eu, should they consider that the processing operations do not comply with the Regulation.

Date when processing starts

Maximum of 30 days after the end user has stopped making use of the device.

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
