

- Employment Injury Insurance
- Pension
- Health Insurance
- Parental Leave

To meet the challenges to Decent Work do we need to re-think how we govern work?

Are we regulating the "right" thing-

Current focus is on regulating relationships* (the employer/employee

relationship)

*with a growing number of workers classified as outside of a relationship to which labour rights and protections attach - means for a growing number of

workers "decent work" has become illusive and the the legitimacy of the employment relationship as basis for distinguishing between the "haves" and "have-nots" has been eroded.
