Since 1999 Eckhard Metze has been the head of the Employers' Liaison office at the Secretariat of KAN, the Commission for Occupational Health and Safety and Standardization. KAN coordinates the views of the German OSH stakeholders regarding national, European and international standardization projects and presents a common position to the standardization process. In this function, Mr Metze represents the interests of the employers, both within KAN and on national standards committees, advisory committees and commissions of DIN, the German institute for standardization. He also advises associations and companies on questions related to standardization. In this context, he is also active in European standardization (CEN) and international standardization (ISO). In addition, he assumes tasks in the area of occupational safety and health for the Federation of German Employers' (BDA) in the European context. This includes work on the BUSINESSEUROPE "Health and Safety" working group, membership of the Advisory Committee on Safety and Health at Work and of the Governing Board and Bureau (deputy member) and the TARAG and OKAG WG of EU-OSHA. At national level, Mr Metze represents the BDA on committees of the German Social Accident Insurance (DGUV) and the German OSH Strategy (GDA). Furthermore, he is active on various committees and working groups of German industry associations.
