1. General introduction

1.1. Legal basis

Council Regulation (EC) No 2062/94 of 18 July 1994 setting up a European Agency for Safety and Health at Work (OJ L 216, 20.8.1994, page 1) modified by Council Regulation (EC) No 1643/95 (OJ L 156, 7.7.1995, page, 1).

1.2. Explanatory statement

This amending Budget I for 2010 has been prepared in order to comply with Agency's Financial Regulations :

- to decrease the EC subsidy in the respective EU-OSHA's statement of revenue & expenditure by € 206,566 in order to be in line with the subsidy finally voted in December 2009 by the European Parliament (€ 14,250,000);
- to include the appropriations related to the IPA II programme in the EU-OSHA's statement of revenue & expenditure for a total amount of € 520,731;
- to transfer appropriations (€ 50,000) to budget item "1113 Contract agents" from budget items "1176 Seconded National Experts" (€ 45,000) & "1522 Trainees" (€ 5,000);
- to transfer appropriations (€ 235,000) to budget item "1180 Staff recruitment" from budget items "1190 Salary weighting" (€ 35,000) & "3304 Translations" (€ 200,000);
- to delete in point "2.1. Revenue 2010" the sentence "(this represents an assigned revenue to be spent exclusively for translations)" as this specific revenue must must considered as normal revenue and not earmarked.

2. Justification of main headings

2.1. Revenue 2010

The sources of revenue for the amending budget I in 2010 consist of :

- a main subsidy from the European Commission of € 14,250,000;
- € 207,131 from the Translation Centre following overpayment by EU-OSHA in 2008;
- € 126,100 from Spanish and Local Authorities.

The total established amount for Titles 1, 2 & 3 is therefore € 14,583,231.

The total income for IPA II programme in 2010 is €520,731.

2.2. Expenditure 2010

Title 1 - Staff

Title 1 is increased by \in 200,000. This is explained by the transfer of appropriations between Title 3 and Title 1 in order to allocate to budget item "1180 - Staff recruitment" the necessary appropriations for covering costs incurred by the recruitment procedure of the new EU-OSHA Director.

Budget item "1180 - Staff recruitment" has therefore a new total amount of € 256,000. The increase of € 235,000 is covered by € 200,000 from Title 3 and € 35,000 from budget item "1190 - Salary weighting" (€ 35,000).

Budget item "1113 - Contract agents" is increased by € 50,000 for a new total amount of € 924,000. This increase is covered by € 45,000 from budget item "1176 - Seconded National Expert" & "1522 - Trainess" (€ 5,000).

New total expenditure of the Title 1 is € 5,528,700

Title 2 - Buildings, equipment and miscellaneous operating expenditure

No change.

Title 3 - Operational expenditure

New total expenditure of the Title 3 is \in 7,507,131 and remains at the initial level of activity (\in 7,500,000). The decrease of \in 406,566 is explained by the adjustment of the EC subsidy (\cdot \in 206,566) and the transfer of \in 200,000 to the Title 1.

Title 4 - Expenditure for implementing special projects funded by specific other subsidy

The total expenditure for IPA II programme in 2010 is \leq 520,731.
