





What's in it for me?

The OSH Barometer allows for an easy exploration of the OSH situation in Europe through a set of indicators, covering a range of aspects, such as:

- generic information on OSH authorities, data on economic and sectoral structure, and workforce profiles;
- strategies and regulations;
- working conditions, prevention and OSH culture;
- occupational accidents, diseases and general workplace wellbeing; and
- aspects of OSH legislation enforcement and competent enforcement authorities.

Users can easily visualise the information of their choice, compare results with other countries or EU average, check yearly variations, view the main indicators as infographics, generate customised graphics, download detailed national or topic-specific reports and share content directly on social media.

This public information system is managed jointly by the European Agency for Safety and Health at Work (EU-OSHA) and the European Commission's Directorate-General for Employment, Social Affairs and Inclusion (DG-EMPL).
