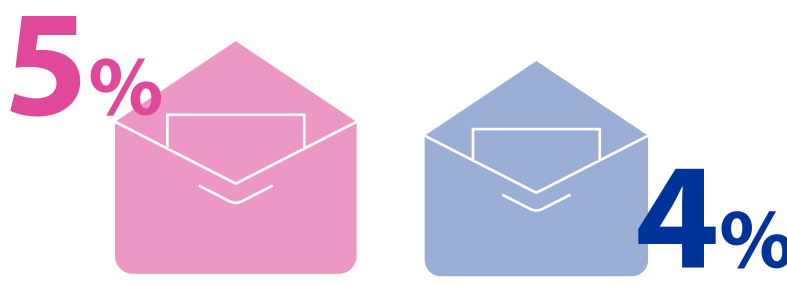

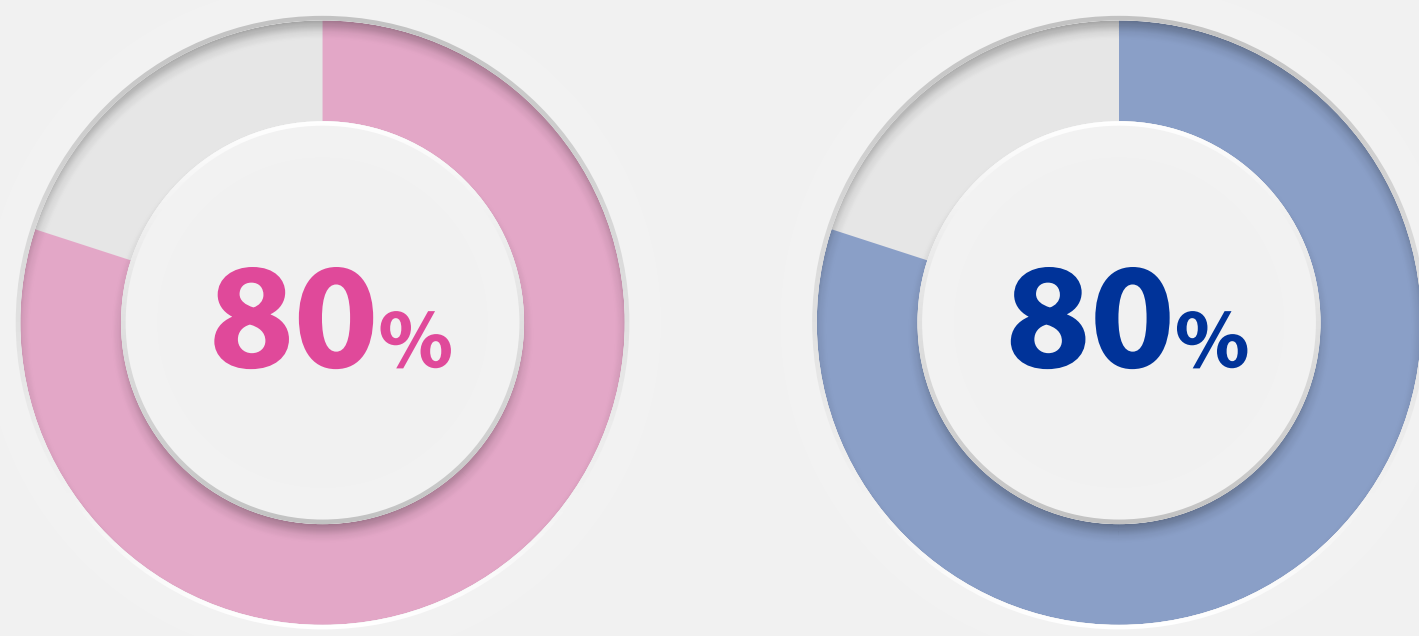

Stakeholders' assessment of relevance

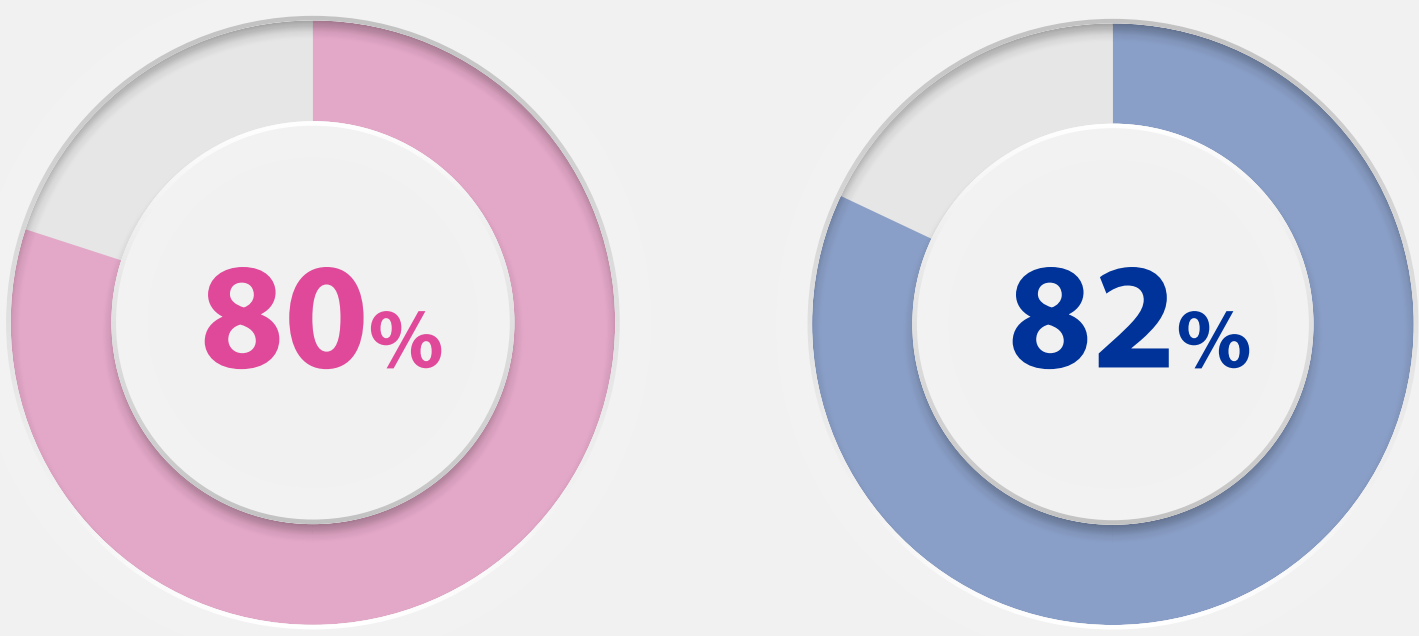

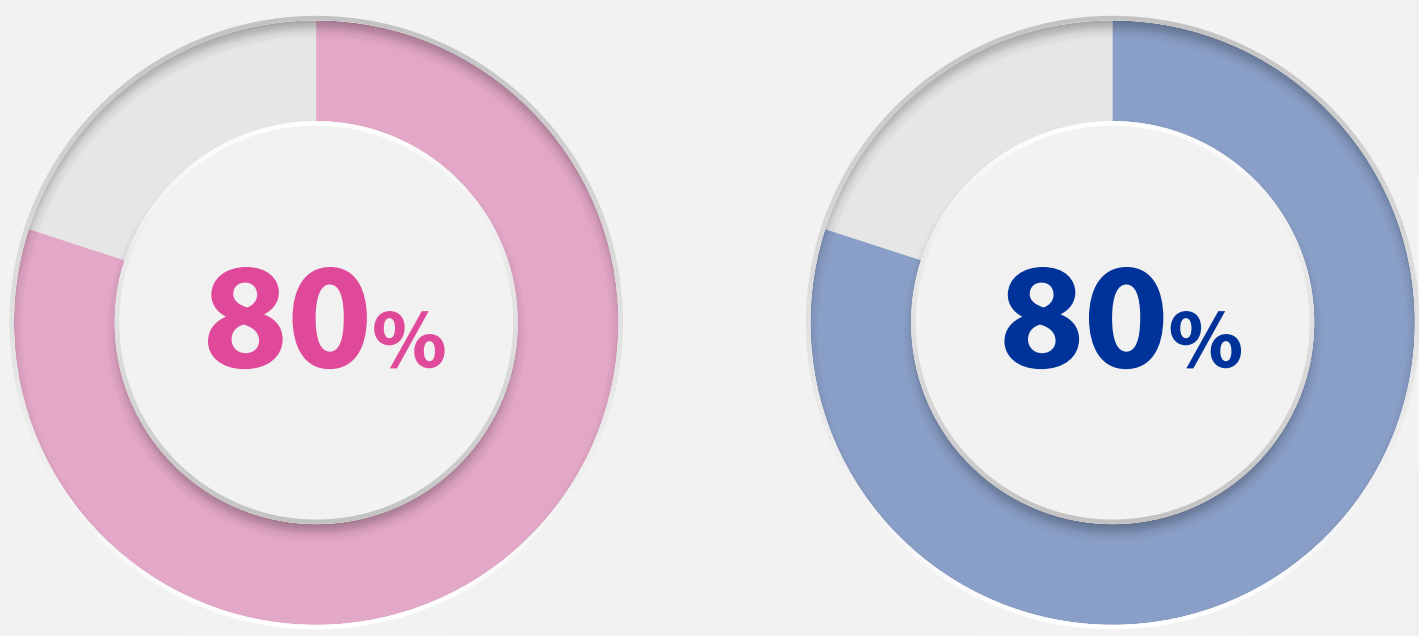

# EVALUATION OF EU-OSH INFORMATION SYSTEMS

## FINDINGS

- ▶ Provided a relevant EU-level reference point for reliable and comparable OSH data and context.
- ▶ Consolidated authoritative sources into one accessible and valued platform for stakeholders.
- ▶ Broadly acknowledged as enabling benchmarking across Member States, trend identification, awareness-raising, and policy discussions.
- ▶ To ensure future relevance and use, need for better outreach to potential users, supporting uptake at national level and expanding scope to new and emerging OSH challenges.



## RECOMMENDATIONS

- ▶ Make updates more regular and automated where feasible, supported by stronger data governance.
- ▶ Improve usability and communication through simpler navigation and more targeted, multilingual outputs.
- ▶ Expand content with new indicators and historical data to capture emerging OSH risks and policy needs.
- ▶ Strengthen EU collaboration to improve data quality, comparability, and timeliness, including through AI use.
