
- **Set up in 1994 by the European Union and based in Bilbao, Spain**

Background of the project

▪ EU OSH Strategic Framework 2014-2020

- One of the 3 major challenges: to improve the prevention of work-related diseases

▪ Background

- EU-OSHA work on rehabilitation and work health promotion;
- Support for the practical prevention of work-related diseases and reintegration;

▪ Cancer specific

- More and more cases in Europe, in particular at working age;
- With better treatment, some cancers are potentially becoming chronic diseases;
- Workers expected to return to work;
- Increasing challenge for enterprises;
- Less reintegration measures and back-to-work measures for workers affected by cancer.

Objectives of the project

- **Review of existing knowledge on instruments and practices to:**
 - raise awareness;
 - provide guidance at the enterprise level.
- **Provision of:**
 - More insight into the problems encountered by workers and employers;
 - Recommendations for enterprises building on examples of policies in place;
 - Support for workplace level management of work-related diseases and their consequences on workers.
